- Closed Session Public Comments requests must be received by the Clerk of the Board prior to the start of the meeting. Other public comments are welcomed at the end of the Commission Action items.
- The SBIAA President will call you to the podium at the appropriate time for you to speak. All comments must be made from the podium in order to be heard.
