



**PROPOSED FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION
TRIENNIAL DBE GOAL FFY 2022-2024
Dated June 16, 2021**

In accordance with 49 CFR Part 26.45(g), the San Bernardino International Airport Authority (Airport), as a recipient of U.S. Department of Transportation assistance, announces a proposed Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) overall Triennial Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 7.3% for Federal Fiscal Years 2022-2024. This race-neutral goal represents the percentage of work anticipated to be performed by certified DBE firms on the Airport's FAA-assisted projects. The methodology used to determine the proposed goal is available for public inspection for thirty (30) days from the date of this notice upon request.

The Airport will host a webinar on July 13, 2021, from 10:00 am – 11:00 am PDT to present the methodology for establishing the proposed DBE goal, provide an opportunity for public comment, and answer any questions about the Airport's DBE program and proposed DBE goal.
